M3F is sponsoring a 3 session A/B/C Invitational Swim Meet on June 20-22, 2008, to be held at the University of Minnesota Aquatic Center pool.

PURPOSE: To have fun, promote competitive swimming in Minnesota and the surrounding states, help teach developmental level swimmers proper racing methods and build self-esteem.

TEAMS: Mach 3 Flyers Swim Team, Team Foxjet, Thunderbay Thunderbolts, Med-City Aquatics, Edina Gators, Twin Cities Swim Club, Oregon Community Swim Club, North Suburban Aquatics, Great Wolf, Swim STMA, Hudson Area Swim Association and others as timeline permits.

ELIGIBILITY: All swimmers of all ages and abilities who are currently 2008 registered members of USA Swimming/FINA Canada are eligible to compete. Additionally, all swimmers must read, sign, and submit the attached University of Minnesota Code of Conduct form prior to the start of competition.

LOCATION: University of Minnesota Aquatic Center pool, 1912 University Ave. SE, Minneapolis, MN. 612-626-1352. Two blocks west of the merging of University and Washington Ave. in Minneapolis. For a map and parking information either click on or cut and paste this link:

FACILITY: The U of MN Aquatic Center pool is 8 lanes, 50 meters, with a continuous depth of 2 meters throughout. Extra wide and long 10° Paragon starting platforms are 26" above the water line. We will use whistle starts and electronic timing with stopwatches and buttons for back-up.

WARM-UP: Current MSI and USA Swimming rules will govern all aspects of the warm-ups and competition. Swimmers and coaches are expected to be acquainted with all rules and obligations. Failure to follow will result in disqualification of swimmer(s) and coach(es) from the next event or expulsion from the meet. **Slip-in entry rule and no diving rule will be strictly enforced.**

ENTRIES: 8 & U swimmers may enter up to 5 individual events. 9&O swimmers may enter up to 7 individual swims. No swimmer may enter more than 2 swims on Friday or 3 swims on Saturday or Sunday.

Entries are due **to Chuck Gannon by 8:00 pm on Monday evening, June 9, 2008.** Late entries will be accepted on the deck, but if room exists in currently seeded events. **Proof of USA membership will be required for all deck entries (Athlete USA Membership Card). If on the spot proof cannot be provided an on-deck USA Registration will be required with the entry (all fees apply).**

All seed times submitted must be in meters.

All Entrants are required to read and sign the attached U of M Code of Conduct. Signed forms must be turned in to the Meet Director at the beginning of the meet.

Email entries are preferred. Please include in the text portion of your email your entry totals: athletes, splashes, and your team name. Any revisions to entries must be a complete replacement of the previous entry file. The previous entries will be deleted. A revised text file must accompany the revised Team Manager file. Please contact the host entry person if you don't receive confirmation of your entries within 24 hours of sending your email. Please call the entries person for directions if you are hand-delivering the entries.

M3F will use the HY-TEK meet program for the meet. Teams on the HY-TEK system may send a disk entry. Those teams not on the HY-TEK or SDIF compatible system can use the entry sheets.

The entering club or its representative will be solely responsible for the accuracy of the entries. A fine of \$25.00/event will be charged for falsifying an entry.

Distance event limitations: Only two of the three distance events (400 IM, 400 Free, 800 Free) may be entered (example: if a swimmer enters the 400IM and the 400 Free that swimmer will be ineligible for the 800 Free). The host club reserves the right to limit the number of entrants into the 400IM, the 400 Free and the 800 Free to 48 fastest swimmers, split equally between the men's and women's division.

TIMED FINALS: The meet is pre-seeded (except for distance events). All swimmers must report to the blocks for the start of their heat. The 400 IM, 400 Free and 800 Free will be deck seeded with positive check-in. They will be swum fastest to slowest, alternately women and men. The Minnesota scratch rule will apply. The host club reserves the right to use fly-over starts and chase starts. **In addition the host club reserves the right to swim two participants per lane in certain distance events.**

Note: Like events will be swum combined age groups for girls and boys respectively. The events will then be scored separately as the order of events reads. For example, events 25, 27 and 29 will be seeded together and swum, followed by events 26, 28 and 30, seeded together and swum. Then events 31 and 33 will be seeded together and swum, followed by 32 and 34, seeded together, and so on.

TIME STANDARDS: The most current Minnesota Time Standards LCM (as of this printing the 2005 Standards LCM were the most current) will be used. Senior events will use the 17 - 18 time standards to qualify. This meet, however, will not be using time standards to differentiate between divisions because we are seeding all swimmers together in an event by time.

TIMELINES: Any timeline provided, whether through MSI phone line or in the meet program is for information purposes only.

SCORING: All events will be scored on a 16-place basis, regardless of entry time or standard. Swims outside a swimmer's age group (e.g., a 12-year-old swimming the senior 200 Fly) will be swum exhibition only and will not score.

AWARDS: In the spirit of the Olympics the top three finishers of each event will be awarded as follows: 1st Place – Gold Medal; 2nd Place – Silver Medal; 3rd Place Bronze Medal. Medal winners will be announced.

RULES AND REGULATIONS: All information, rules and regulations, including time standards, schedules, orders of events, meet operations and requirements will be found in the Minnesota competitive Rules and Regulations and USA Swimming Rules and Regulations current editions.

USA SWIMMING MEMBERSHIP: All swimmers must be current 2008 registered athlete members of USA Swimming/FINA Canada in order to participate in this meet. All teams must have any coaches who are on the deck with the team be 2008 registered non-athlete members of USA Swimming/FINA Canada and current in CPR, First Aid, and Coach Safety. Any individual entering the meet who swims without having current USA Swimming/FINA Canada membership will be subject to a fine of \$25.00 per swimmer per event.

MEET FEES: A flat fee per swimmer covers all costs, including MSI Entrant fee of \$1.50 per swimmer. **Makes checks payable to Mach 3 Flyers Swim Team.** Swimmers 8 & U pay \$35/swimmer, swimmers 9 & O pay \$45/swimmer. All fees are in US dollars.

MEET COMMITTEE: Upon arrival at the meet, a meet review committee will be formed which deal with particular meet issues, which may require governing by the committee. The committee will be comprised of the meet referee and two coaches and two swimmers not from the host team, chosen at the beginning of the meet.

COACHES' MEETINGS: Coaches' meetings will take place on a regular basis at the discretion of the referee.

CONCESSIONS: No concessions will be available at the meet. There are a variety of restaurants and stores within walking distance of the aquatic center. Absolutely no food is permitted on the pool deck or locker rooms. No glass containers of any variety are permitted in the pool area.

Hospitality: A hospitality room will be provided for coaches, officials, and volunteers.

CODE OF CONDUCT: It is a requirement of the University of Minnesota that each participating swimmer in a meet held at the UM Aquatic Center sign a Code of Conduct form which insures that each swimmer is aware of the rules of pool use and the consequences for breaking such rules. This is a necessity to maintain the pool for future meets and to satisfy the University that care will be taken by the users to keep the facility clean and safe for others.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Purpose

The purpose of this Code is to promote the best possible team and individual impression at all times, and to acknowledge each individual's responsibilities as members of our team.

Part I - General Conduct

1. All participating team members shall abide by this Code of Conduct.
2. Curfews will be strictly obeyed unless participant has contacted the coach for an extension.
3. The use of alcoholic beverages is forbidden.
4. The use of drugs other than those prescribed by your physician is forbidden.
5. The use of tobacco products is forbidden.
6. The use of fireworks is forbidden.
7. Indiscreet or destructive behavior will not be tolerated. Every effort should be made to avoid guilt by association with such activities.
8. Swimmers will treat their membership on the team as a privilege and personally acknowledge those responsibilities associated with it.

All the above items will be strictly enforced in relation to the Aquatic Center <u>AND</u> the Radisson Hotel Metrodome.
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Part II - Violation of the Code

The coach, chaperone and meet management officials have the power to impose penalties for violation of the Code. The penalties include, but are not limited to, the following:

- The Swimmer will be scratched from the meet.
- The Swimmer will be evicted from the Radisson Hotel Metrodome.

By signing the attached Code Of Conduct Signature sheet, I hereby agree to abide by the rules of conduct set forth in Part I above and acknowledge that, should I violate any provision of Part I, I will be subject to disciplinary actions as set forth in Part II, including suspension.
