Name of Legislation: Champ Is a Champ

Description of Issue:

Coaches & Teams differ on their approach to finals meets with swimmers who have one time standard in yards and a different time standard in meters.

Solution/Rationale and Proposal/Legislation Requested:

For ALL finals meets, (State, A or B or C finals), a swimmer must swim at the highest Level they have achieved in an event, no matter what the course.

Example:

Swimmer X has a champ time in meters and the best time X has in yards is only an A time. (They have a champ time!) The swimmer would have to enter the state meet in that event and may not swim that event at A/B Finals.

Swimmers must enter the finals meets in their actual time (No converted times and No TSE – time standard equivalent). They must enter times in the course achieved. (Indicate yards or meters). The athlete will be seeded accordingly with conforming times (yards/meters for that meet) and non-conforming times (yards/meters NOT for the current meet)..
